This year to celebrate Harvest Festival, Byfleet Primary School have decided to support our Local Foodbank. Although it is part of Woking Foodbank, Byfleet is very lucky to have a very local satellite foodbank at The Methodist Church, in Byfleet.

The foodbank helps local families and have been operational throughout Lockdown helping those in need. They can deliver or people can go to them and receive food parcels when times are hard. Byfleet community is known for pulling together and as we all know, charity begins at home, so what better way to combine celebrating Harvest and helping local foodbanks.

Donations can be bought into school from <u>Monday 5th October – Friday 16th October</u> and put in a box in your child's classroom, allowing for a two week window for items to be collected, so that they can be delivered to The Methodist Church in time for distribution to people in need.

Any non-perishable items are greatly received, but foods are needed the most:

The Foodbank is now open (Wednesdays 1230 - 2.30 pm) and operating as normally as can be expected in these challenging times. In order to minimise contact, a new e-referral system is now in operation in parallel with the paper Red Vouchers. We are also able to offer a delivery service, within the Byfleet area, for those who are self-isolating or otherwise unable to go to a Foodbank in person. In cases of emergency need, deliveries can be arranged outside of the Foodbank's opening hours.

They just ask for no perishable items as they can spoil and pass their sell by date before delivery to families. The foodbank also asks for items which have a long shelf life.
