#### Remote Learning and Local Lock Down


- We are delighted to have taken receipt of 42 chrome books this week 10 were donated by our EEEA Trust for our teaching staff, to allow them to adequately prepare in the event of a local lock down and remote learning needing to take place. The other 32 chrome books have kindly been donated by the FRIENDS of Byfleet Primary, for our children to use as part of their Computing lessons and to teach the children how to use Google Classroom. We are extremely thankful to both EEEA and our Byfleet FRIENDS for their kind donations to help us achieve our school priorities this year.
- We hope you've all had a chance to log onto your child's Google email to access their Google Classroom. Your child's log on sticker can be located in the inside cover of their reading diary. Please go to Google.com and log into your child's Google email using your child's log on sticker in their diary.
- Once you have logged onto your child's email account, please click on the 'waffle' and look for the green and yellow Google Classroom APP.



- Please note that you will need to have accessed your child's Google Classroom log on to be able to have your parent evening slot via Google Hangout next half term. You are also able to download 'Google Classroom' as an APP, which may make things easier.
- If you decide to change your child's password, please update this on the sticker inside their reading diary so that they can access this during computing lessons.

#### Anti-bullying and Behaviour

I hope you've all managed to see our Behaviour Summary that was sent home this week outlining our new draft Behaviour Policy. Since the start of the term, we have repeatedly been reminding our children about making the right behaviour choices, celebrating good behaviour and encouraging our children to use STOP (start telling other people) as a way to help us keep play and learning times safe and happy and continuing to build on relationships.

#### **School Improvement**

We have carried out pupil progress meeting with all the teachers and identified which pupils will benefit from additional support to help them catch up and keep up. With the benefit of having an additional adult in each class, we are fortunate to be able to run small group and 1:1 TA interventions in the afternoons, which are up and running. Our SENDCo, Mrs Brackenbury, is working hard behind the scenes to help our teachers put individual plans and targets into place to support our SEND pupils with our teachers, which will be shared with individual parents in Autumn 2 so that these targets can be worked on further at home.

We cannot thank our active *Byfleet FRIENDS charity* enough for their kind donation of 32 chrome books and storage trolleys – it's amazing what a collective and proactive group of people can achieve, along with the kindness of your ongoing donations to support them.
