National Lockdown

With a national lockdown in place, we will continue to keep our school open for 'business as usual'. Please do continue to send your children in to school every day and we will update you on any safety changes we need to

make as we review our risk assessment regularly and in line with government guidance. If you feel that your child is not well enough to attend school, please let us know each day by phoning the school. In the instance that we need to move to using remote learning, we will communicate how we will be using *Google Classroom* at home to support your child's learning. We hope that you have had a chance to familiarise yourself with *Google Classroom* when you logged into your child's Google email account to access your Parents' Evening.



Surrey County Council have issued us the following message: Just to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority, they will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices.

School Improvement

This week Miss Forde, our English Leader, worked with SLT to moderate Writing across the school. We are currently looking at how we can improve the teaching of grammar and explicit writing skills, like using different sentence types, a range of punctuation and making interesting vocabulary choices. We will continue to use our text-based approach where all writing lessons are planned around a theme from a book that the class is studying. Please ask your children which book they are reading as a class as we are working hard to put reading at the heart of our curriculum.

Clubs

Unfortunately, following government guidance, we have to cancel Ultimate Coaching's Monday football and gymnastic clubs and Wednesday's dodgeball. The only club provision we are advised to offer is for the purpose of childcare. As a result, wrap around care <u>before and after school</u> will continue if this provision is used for: a.) childcare for parents who are working or studying, b.) for respite for vulnerable children. We are so sad that we have had to take this decision as we know how important daily exercise and sport is for emotional and physical wellbeing for our children.

We still have space available in our <u>Breakfast Club and Afterschool Club</u> if you wish your child to attend. We have thought carefully about this provision, where the children are separated into the bubbles that they use during the school day so your child(ren) will not be mixing with other bubbles. Please contact the school office to enquire or book a place for your child.
