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


Warm Fleeces - school uniform

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National Lockdown and King's Pre-school on site at Byfleet

We have been notified that we are one of a handful of schools in Surrey that hasn't had a 'bubble' closure yet. We feel fortunate to still be open for 'business as usual' to provide your child(ren) with a well-structured and full curriculum during this second national lockdown, allowing them to catch up on lost learning and support their wellbeing. We urge you to continue sending your children into school if they are well enough to do so. We have recently made the arrangement with *King's Pre-school* who are based on our school site, that if either of our settings were to have a potential or confirmed case of Covid, then we will be transparent and notify each other. This will allow us to restrict any further outbreaks. Please be advised that if you are requested to self-isolate or seek a test for your child(ren) by either myself, Mrs Meyrick or Kerry, the manager at King's Pre-school (if a sibling attends this nursery setting), then we will communicate this between our two settings and liaise with families involved. Thank you for cooperating with us and helping us keep our community safe.

School Improvement

Mrs Elliot, our Deputy Head, has been working hard behind the scenes to improve our playtimes and PE lessons; we will shortly be having a traverse-climbing wall and outdoor gym installed in our playground, along with some climbing equipment for our Reception children. We know this will hugely benefit our children's physical development and provide them with some fun activities during PE lessons and play times, perfect for developing their fitness and wellbeing.
