
Byfleet Crowdfund

You may have seen the extremely kind Crowdfunding that was set up by a local Byfleet resident, to raise funds for our children on Facebook. Google Classroom can now also be accessed on Xbox and Playstations if you feel your child would benefit from this. Here is a tutorial showing you how to access this.








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




Feeling Stressed or Anxious?
