
Dear Parents/Carers,

Returning to School

- Thank you so much for the calm staggered start to the school day. Please continue to <u>only arrive at your allocated time slot to avoid congestion</u>. If <u>younger</u> siblings are being dropped off, then Year 3/4 children may wait at their allocated area (Yr 3 pavement, Yr4 staff car park).
- If your child is in Year 5/6 then they can come into school independently. Please then wait until 8.40 with your Year 3/4 (if applicable). *Only Year 3/4 children who have younger siblings may be dropped off before 8.40.*
- RECEPTION: At the end of the day, if you have a child in Reception with a sibling in Year 3/4, please collect your reception child at 2.40 then wait at the school gate for your Year 3/4 child to be dismissed at 2.55.
- RECEPTION: At the end of the day, if you have a child in Reception with a sibling in Year 5/6, a member of staff will bring your child to the school gate at 3pm so that this time coincides with your collection of Year 5/6 at 3.00.
- Families of children in both Year 3/4 and 5/6, please socially distance whilst waiting outside for your older children.
